We have no new cases of the Coronavirus disease (COVID-19) at Splendido. Here are the latest updates for our community:

SONORA UPDATES:

We continue to conduct routine testing for employees who work at Sonora, which is required by Pima County Department of Health and the Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS). Each week for the past three weeks, we have tested residents who live at Sonora. I am happy to share that those test results have been negative.

We have now had a period of time of greater than 14 days with no new positive cases. Therefore, we are able to resume our plans for outdoor visitation, small group activities, and compassionate care visits. We will provide additional information soon on the visitation options.

INDEPENDENT LIVING DINING OPTIONS RESUMING:

Thank you for your patience over the past two weeks as we paused al fresco dining on Granada Patio along with indoor dining in Alonzo's. We have now resumed al fresco dining on the Granada Patio.
