Dear Employees of Splendido,

## **INDEPENDENT LIVING UPDATE:**

We wanted to inform you that we learned late yesterday, November 11, 2020, that **two employees in Independent Living have tested positive for the Coronavirus disease (COVID-19)**. These employees are recovering at home and following guidance from their physicians. We wish them a speedy recovery. Splendido is interviewing these individuals to determine if either of them was in close contact with residents and/or other employees (meaning within 6 feet of anyone for more than 15 minutes).

## **TESTING EMPLOYEES**

With Pima County seeing a steady rise in cases, Splendido will test employees who work in Independent Living. This is a proactive measure to identify any employees who may be asymptomatic.

## **PAUSING INDOOR & OUTDOOR DINING**

As a precaution, **we have paused our restaurant service in Alonzo's and on the Granada Patio**. This is a short-term measure, and we look forward to resuming indoor and al fresco meal service in the near future.

## **SONORA UPDATE:**

Routine testing of both residents and employees who work at Sonora continues. There are no new positive cases to report.

## **NEW GUIDANCE URGING PEOPLE TO STAY HOME:**

As the Thanksgiving holiday approaches—and we experience a surge in cases across the country to unprecedented numbers—we ask you to limit travel as much as possible. We urge residents and employees alike to consider staying at home and only leaving for essential activities, which include visiting the pharmacy and buying groceries.
