

COVID-19 UPDATE

February 10, 2022

Dear Splendido Residents,

We wanted to inform you that we have learned that **one Sonora resident and an independent contractor who works in Sonora have tested positive for COVID-19**. We wish these individuals a speedy recovery.

Splendido is interviewing these individuals to determine if they were in close contact with residents and/or other employees (meaning within 6 feet of anyone for more than 15 minutes).

SONORA STATUS:

Sonora continues to follow outbreak protocols, including regular COVID-19 testing until there are no more positive cases for 14 days. Sonora residents should refrain from Independent Living programs and dining, though they can order takeout from Alonzo's. Also, Sonora residents can move freely around their own care neighborhood, but we are limiting movement between neighborhoods and have paused group programs in Sabino.

Visitors to Sonora are still welcome, with the following precautions:

- All visitors must wear a face mask at all times.
- Visitors will be screened at the concierge before entering Sonora.
- Visitors must maintain physical distancing of at least 6 feet from residents.

We continue practice strong infection control and sanitation protocols in Sonora and throughout Splendido to minimize the spread of the virus.

STEPS FOR STAYING SAFE:

Please help keep the virus out of our community with these steps:

1. If you have cold-like symptoms, **STAY HOME** and contact your physician.
2. Practice **good hand hygiene** by washing your hands frequently for 20 or more seconds, or using hand sanitizer.
3. Practice **physical distancing** with others (no closer than 6 feet away for no more than 15 minutes).
4. **Wear a surgical face mask** that covers your mouth and nose any time you are indoors in public.

Take care and stay well.
