

COVID-19 UPDATE

May 24, 2022

Dear Splendido Residents,

We wanted to inform you that we have learned that **four residents who live in Sonora and one employee who works in Independent Living have tested positive for COVID-19.** We wish these individuals a speedy recovery. Splendido is interviewing the individuals to determine if they were in close contact with residents and/or other employees (meaning within 6 feet of anyone for more than 15 minutes).

SONORA PROTOCOLS IN PLACE

We are conducting initial testing for residents of Sonora and employees who work there. We will continue to test twice a week until there are no more positive cases for 14 days.

Visitor update: We encourage visits to occur outdoors when possible or in the resident's suite. Visitors must wear a mask at all times indoors and physically distance from others. If you are experiencing any cold-like symptoms or have recently attended a large gathering—we encourage deferring your visit.

INDEPENDENT LIVING UPDATE:

- There are no changes for residents in Independent Living.

HELP STOP THE SPREAD:

If you feel ill—even with mild, cold-like symptoms—please stay in your home to help reduce the spread of the virus in our community. **If you are experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19, or if you have tested positive, please reach out to your physician, and let the Concierge know.**

Please continue to follow these simple steps. They are the most effective way to reduce your risk of infection:

- Practice **good hand hygiene** by washing your hands frequently for 20 or more seconds, or using hand sanitizer.
- **Wear a surgical face mask** that covers your mouth and nose any time you are indoors in public.
